## The poetry of bodies, an exhibition of Art video

The artists come from France and Francophone countries like Swizerland or Liban. They develop their own filmic language and they manipulate digital image to create a new reality. They transform and superimpose images, they create an editing of images taken from different times, places or from the history of art and cinema, they slow down the image or accelerate it. The sound is also important: voices or music create a rhythm and an energy and they complete the pictures.

In all these videos, the artists question the body: female body, stereotypes of beauty, public face, anonymous person or individual reality, the place of body in today's society...

## Screen 1 « Women »

This first set is composed with portraits of women. The artists, female or male, work about all the dimensions of the woman: her physical appearence, her intimity, her memory, her psychology... The artists explore the passage from an emotional state to another one, from the reality to the dream or the nightmare. They create a new vision of the woman, more complexified and deeper.
